Introduction

This report sets out the value of the value of Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) that the Council has received and spent in 2016/17.

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)

In summer 2014, Purbeck District Council adopted a CIL charging schedule. CIL is a tariff-based planning charge that enables the Council to raise funds from development to contribute to district-wide infrastructure. The levy is charged at a set amount per square metre of additional floor area that varies depending on the development type and housing sub-market region within the district.

Purbeck District Council passed on 15% of CIL receipts for development in the Parish to Swanage Town Council.
