19. INTERNAL AUDIT REPORT 2014/15

Consideration was given to the annual internal audit report for 2014/15, prepared by Darkin-Miller – Chartered Accountants. The document provided background information and explanations regarding the recommendations and conclusions in respect of the Council's services, in accordance with the internal audit's objective to provide an appraisal function for the review of the Council's internal control system.

The results of the reviews completed during the year had resulted in an overall opinion that in all material respects:

- Key central systems and internal control arrangements continued to be effective;
- Agreed policies, regulations and Standing Orders were complied with;
- Managers were aware of the importance of maintaining internal controls and accepted recommendations made by Internal Audit to improve internal controls; and
- Adequate arrangements were in place to prevent and detect fraud.

Arising from the above, Members noted that the number of recommendations made during the 2014/15 audit was higher than that of 2013/14, but agreed that this was not unexpected with a change in auditor.
