Dear Mr. Ayers,

Request for a new bye-law.

Please ask the Town Council to give consideration to the making of a new bye-law.
The wording to be along the lines of the following :-

"Parking of motorised vehicles."

It shall be against the law to Park any motorised vehicle or vehicle trailer in such a position that it impedes the passage of any pedestrian, wheelchair, perambulator, or senior citizen's carriage from passing between any parked vehicle or vehicle trailer and the boundary fence /wall/ hedge of any property or between the vehicle or vehicle trailer, and any lamp post ,telegraph pole, letterbox, electricity junction box or any other street furniture.

The parked vehicle or trailer (whether connected to a towing vehicle) or not, shall leave a minimum of one meter of clear space at all times.

This request is particularly important for Blind and poorly sighted people, for people with ambulatory problems (particularly users of wheelchairs), and young children.

It is also for the safety of all people when during winter time and in adverse weather conditions, road vehicles inevitable pick up mud, and when parked the detritus falls from the wheel arches and mud guards onto the footway surface ,making it slippery and eventually finding its way into people's homes. This is particularly important for elderly people ,aggravating the difficulties that they experience in cleaning their homes.

Evidence is to be by photograph which shall be submitted with details of when the picture was taken and who it was taken was taken by.
