Thank you Alison,

I would imagine needing 6-12 permits as this would cover the main training crews and coxs (each crew has 6 crew and a cox) which would cover 1 Men's team and 1 Ladies team.

Training (and therefore parking) is required on:

Monday's 5-7 Juniors
Tuesday 6-8 (Men's training and open rowing so coxs) Wednesday (Ladies Training) Thursday 6-8 (Men's Training)
Fridays 6-8 (open rowing so coxs) Saturday 10-12 (open rowing) 12-2 Men's/Ladies Training Sunday (8-12)
Men's/Ladies Training

It's a very busy club with a remit to get local people active and using the facilities so any help given would be appreciated.

Not sure what VRM means (guessing it's vehicle registration ?) and if so then possibly yes. If we had the option of say paying £75 for an annual car park pass then that would help. Failing that a few general ones for people to use when at the club.

I'm a member of the Swanage Sea Rowing Club based by the pier. We have quite a few members (including me) that train regularly at the gig shed and in the bay. We represent Swanage in Regattas across the South.

The only parking available is the car park behind the gig shed however this is very expensive at £1.50 per hour.

We have a Men/Ladies and Juniors rowing team and some train 4/5 times a week for 2 hrs a time all year.

Is there a way to reduce the parking fees that we have to pay to make it easier for members ? The car parks are empty however we still have to park elsewhere (where it's cheaper/free) and then walk to rowing.

Perhaps an annual parking permit that's a fair compromise ?
Anything you can do would be appreciate.
